1. CYFLWYNIAD

1.3. Mae "Diogelu" yn gysyniad sy'n cwmpasu mwy nag amddiffyn plant ac oedolion ac mae'n ymwneud â hyrwyddo:

- Iechyd corfforol, emosiynol a meddyliol
- Amddiffyn rhag niwed ac esgeuluso
- Addysg, hyfforddiant a hamdden
- Cyfraniad i gymdeithas
- Llesiant cymdeithasol ac economaidd

2. PWRPAS Y DDOGFEN HON

- rhoi lle canolog i les plant ac oedolion yn ein polisiau a'n gweithdrefnau
- cydweithio mewn partneriaeth agos â chymdeithasau, plant, eu rhieni, gofalwyr ac oedolion ac asiantaethau eraill i ddiogelu a hyrwyddo lles plant ac oedolion
- parchu hawliau, dymuniadau, teimladau a phreifatrwydd plant ac oedolion drwy wrando arnynt a lleihau unrhyw risgiau a all effeithio arnynt
- ymyrraeth gynnar a cheisio osgoi sefyllfa lle y bydd cam-drin neu honiadau am gam-drin neu niweidio yn gallu codi.

**POLICY FOR THE PROTECTION OF YOUNG
PEOPLE AND ADULTS**

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 As a Community Council, we believe that every child and adult has a right to be safe from harm. The Council acknowledges its role and responsibilities to provide definite guidance for staff, Councillors, partners and those people whom we serve in this key field

1.2 “Safeguarding” is everybody’s business in every service within the Council. Whilst Social Services is the lead service for dealing with enquiries regarding allegations / concerns that children and adults may be suffering significant harm, everyone has a responsibility to safeguard the welfare of children, young people and adults whatever the role of the individual

1.3 “Safeguarding” is a wider concept that the protection of children and adults and deals with the promoting of:

- Physical, emotional and mental health
- Protection from harm and neglect
- Education, training and leisure
- Contribution to society
- Social and economic well-being

2. PURPOSE OF THIS DOCUMENT

The purpose of this document is to introduce the Council’s “Policy for Safeguarding Children and Adults”.

2.1. Objectives and Principles of the Policy

2.1.1. Objectives

- to demonstrate how Llanfairpwllgwyngyll Community Council undertakes its commitments in the field of Safeguarding children and adults
- to give assurance to members of the public, service users, Councillors, employees and people working on behalf of the Council that there are arrangements in place to safeguard and protect children and adults
- that Council staff and Councillors have guidelines for when a child or adult may be at risk of harm

2.1.2. Principles

As a Council we believe that it is always unacceptable for a child or an adult to be abused or harmed in any way. This is reflected in the following principles which form the basis of the Policy:-

- every child and adult (whatever their background, culture, age, disability, gender, ethnicity, religious belief) has a right to participate in a safe society without any violence, fear, abuse, bullying and discrimination
- every child and adult has the right to be protected from harm, exploitation and abuse
- we as a Council will put the welfare of children and adults centrally in our policies and procedures
- as a Council we will work closely in partnership with children, their parents, carers and adults and other agencies to safeguard and promote the welfare of children and adults
- respect the rights, wishes, feelings and privacy of children and adults by listening to them and minimising any risks that may affect them
- early intervention and try to avoid situation where abuse or allegations of abuse or harm may occur

3. RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

- 3.1 Every Councillor, every member of staff, every volunteer and every contracted service provider or user of the Council facilities has a responsibility to adhere to the procedures and guidance set out in this policy
- 3.2 By following the correct procedures and guidance, it is possible to ensure that the appropriate steps are implemented to deal with any allegation or concern, services are planned and delivered in a way which safeguards children and adults and staff are able to conduct themselves safely
- 3.3 Every member of staff, Councillor, volunteer and service provider has a responsibility in the field of safeguarding. It is very important to highlight this.

4. THE REFERRAL PROCESS

- 4.1 Any member of staff with concerns regarding the safety of an individual or the behaviour of a colleague towards children or an adult should contact the Community Council Clerc or Chairman immediately.
- 4.2 If there are concerns about the welfare or safety of a child, please contact the Social Services at Anglesey County Council on:

4.4 The Police must be contacted immediately if the child or adult is in immediate danger

5. REPORTING, MONITORING AND REVIEWING

5.1 This Safeguarding Policy will be reviewed annually or if any amendments occur in legislation or in consideration of changes in working practices which may stem from incidents or allegations
